- <u>Important note</u>: If you have any in-progress ACG courses that are not completed prior to our migration date, you'll have 60 days after migration to complete them; otherwise you will lose your course progress and need to restart that course on Pluralsight. We encourage you to wrap up any in-progress courses that you can. Any outstanding courses will be found under "In Progress" on the Pluralsight home page and you'll be redirected to the ACG platform to complete those courses.
