The following plan add-on licenses can be assigned with user-level authorization:

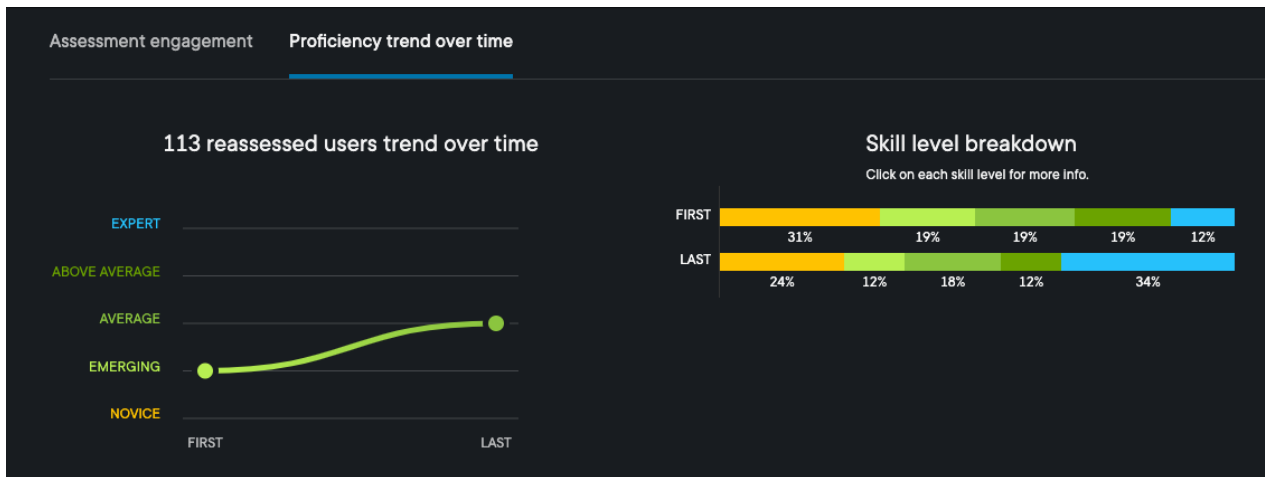
- Labs and sandboxes
